SHOW HOURS: Check-in will be from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Saturday, 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. on Sunday. Judging will begin promptly at 9:00 AM BOTH DAYS. Advertised show hours for the public are 10:00 AM - 4:00 PM each day.

Permission from show management must be obtained to leave earlier.

All entry and miscellaneous fees are due and payable to Buckeye Ohio Rollers within 24 hours of submission of entry or final PAYMENT deadline of Tuesday, July 7, 2026 @ 9:00 PM, whichever comes first. Regardless of the date of entry.

ALL fees must be paid or postmarked within the entry category, i.e. First (Early Bird), Second or Third Tiers.

FINAL DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES, PLACEHOLDER CONVERSION, ETC. IS MONDAY, JULY 6, 2026 BY 9 PM EASTERN.

Fees and due and payable upon entry, including placeholders, even if you fail to bench. Returned payments will incur a \$50 fee. NO REFUNDS!

Multiple entry discounts apply to cats with at least one shared owner ONLY. Proof of registration may be requested.

Junior Exhibitor (JE) Pricing: The Junior Exhibitor ring is open to anyone under 18 years old. Must be ENTERED BY July 6th 9PM Eastern and PAID by July 7th @ 9:00 PM Eastern - \$90. Cat must be owned and shown by JE to qualify for this rate. One entry at this rate per JE, max three per family.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES:

Grooming space: \$50

Exhibition/Sales Cage: \$50 – Must have entry in the show. Remember that show rules specify no more than 2 adults, or 1 adult and 2 kittens, or 4 kittens, per double space.

Guaranteed End of Row (if not handicapped): \$25

NO PAYPAL OR ZELLE PAYMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 11:59PM EASTERN TIME, TUESDAY, JULY 7, 2026. This deadline is hard and fast. **Electronic payments at check-in will NOT be accepted.**

ALL FEES NOT PAID BY TUESDAY, JULY 7, 2026 9 PM EASTERN WILL INCUR AN ADDITIONAL \$25 FEE AND MUST BE MADE IN CASH AT THE DOOR.

SPONSORSHIPS:

Show sponsor: \$100 All Rings (Provide wording in summary)

Ring sponsor: \$25 per ring

No limit in each ring or how many rings you can sponsor. Specify number of rings, judge names, and sponsorship wording in summary field.

SHOW CATALOGS: Unless you request and pay for a printed show catalog (\$20), you will receive your show catalog no later than the Thursday before the show by email as a PDF file. When you enter you need to indicate if you want a printed show catalog. The electronic catalog will be sent to the email address you have registered in TOES. We will NOT have extra hard copy catalogs for sale at the show.

AIRPORT: Fly into Cleveland (CLE), about 40 minutes from the show hall. The club cannot be responsible for exhibitor transportation. Rental cars are available at the airport. Every effort will be made to start and complete the show ON TIME each day. We respect your time and appreciate your support of the show/club.

First Cat Show? Let our entry clerk know! No experience is necessary. Beginners and ALL Healthy Cats are welcome.

Show Rules: TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. By entering, exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and show committee. Declawed cats are only allowed for entry pursuant to TICA Show Rule 23.5 (allowed for household pet or household pet kitten entries or if proof is submitted with entry that the declawing occurred prior to May 1, 2020, and that same cat was shown prior to the rule change on May 1, 2020).

Registration: Except for cats competing in the Preliminary New Breed, Advanced New Breed, and New Traits classes, registration with TICA is not necessary to compete in the cat's first show. Cats do need to be eligible for registration. However, to be scored for TICA titles and Regional / International awards, all cats (other than household pet kittens) must be registered by their second show. Please contact TICA for registration forms and information (TICA, P. O. Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551).

Awards: Plaques will be awarded in accordance with TICA Show Rules.

Health Requirements: This is a non-vetted show. Cats showing signs of ear mites, fleas, fungus, or other illness will be escorted from the show hall, along with any other cats owned, housed, or agented by the same exhibitor. All entries should be immunized against feline rhinotracheitis, calici virus, and panleukopenia, and should test negative for feline leukemia and feline AIDS. Any feline from a house or cattery where there has been fungus or any infectious or contagious illness within twenty-one (21) days prior to the opening day of the show is ineligible for entry. An obviously pregnant or lactating cat will be disqualified. TICA show rules require all claws, front and back, be clipped prior to judging.

Kittens: All kittens (pedigreed or HHP) entered for competition must be at least four (4) and less than eight (8) calendar months old on the day of the show. No kitten under three (3) months of age will be allowed in the show hall (be prepared to show proof of age). Kittens may be spayed or neutered.

Household Pets: Household pets are very welcome at this show! Declawed Household Pets are OK at TICA shows. This is due to the number of HHPs that are rescue cats and may have already been declawed at the time of rescue. Household pets eight (8) months of age and older MUST be spayed or neutered. If you are not sure of the proper class or color of your cat, check out <http://www.seregiontica.org/Colors/intro.htm> or you may send a color photo of the cat to the entry clerk along with a description of the hair length on the tail. Measure if necessary. You will also have an opportunity Saturday morning to have the senior judge make a final determination if the color / pattern is still in question.

Benching: THIS IS A BRING YOUR OWN CAGE SHOW. A full cage size is 44"L x 22"W x 22"H. Per show rules, all cages must be covered on the sides and top. THIS INCLUDES COVERING MESH OR VINYL AREAS OF SHOW TENTS SUCH AS STURDICAGES. You may want to bring a rug, blanket, etc. for the bottom of the cage and other items to help your cat feel more comfortable. No more than one adult cat or 2 kittens are allowed per single cage. NO KITTENS OR CATS MAY BE CONFINED TO CARRIERS, EITHER DISPLAYED OR UNDER CAGES, DURING SHOW HOURS.

Supplies: Cat litter will be available, but please bring your own litter pan and food and water dishes

Grooming Spaces: These measure approximately 22 inches x 22 inches x 44 inches. Available for purchase, in no case is vending permitted from your benching / grooming space.

For Sale: Sales cages space is available, only exhibitors who have entered and are showing cats in competitive classes are eligible and requires payment with other registration fees. If you are bringing cats or kittens to sell, you are strongly advised to familiarize yourself with the applicable statutes. The club takes no responsibility for your failure to do so.
